

# Skills info regarding dimension questions.

There will be two competition fields operating throughout the day. One field will be designated for ages 7U–10U, while the other will be designated for ages 11U–14U. Both fields will utilize 200-foot dimensions; however, all event distances and competition areas will be adjusted as needed to accommodate the appropriate age groups and standard field dimensions.

For younger divisions, cone markers will be used to designate age-appropriate locations for each event. Throwing and hitting stations may be moved closer based on the age group and the dimensions of the infield. For example, younger participants in the throwing event will throw from a location near the outfield grass behind second base rather than from the full distance used by older divisions.

The throwing event is designed to simulate an outfielder making a throw from center field to home plate. Participants will throw toward a target mounted on a simple A-frame structure positioned at home plate. A point will be awarded if the ball makes contact with any part of the target frame or target area.
